A year ago, Oregon State University entered into an agreement with the University of New Brunswick that provided for continued publication of the Journal under the combined banner of Oregon State University and the University of New Brunswick. That arrangement was intended to provide a time buffer during which a more permanent home for the Journal could be found. I am pleased to announce with this insert that the Journal will henceforth be published by the Forest Products Society.
