CALL FOR MANUSCRIPTS

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GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Manuscripts submitted for consideration by Conflict Quarterly should be sent to: Dr. David Charters, Executive Editor, Conflict Quarterly, Centre for Conflict Studies, University of New Brunswick, Fredericton, New Brunswick, Canada, E3B 5A3. Authors must provide three copies of the proposed article/ review, in either English or French, and if possible, a copy on a 5-1/4" or 3-1/2" diskette using Word Perfect 4.1, Word Pefect 4.2 or Olivetti SWS software. They should be accompanied by an abstract of 100-200 words and by a biographical note on the author. Ideally submissions should be 2500-5000 words in length, with complete endnotes included on separate sheets. Manuscripts must be typed or word-processed and double-spaced. Any tables, charts or graphs must be on separate sheets and in camera-ready form. These should be kept to a minimum. For standard punctuation, documentation and format, see Turabian Manual for Writers (5th ed.).

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
