This bibliography lists selected publications and studies related to Newfoundland and Labrador for the twelve months prior to January 1985. This being *Newfoundland Studies'* initial bibliography, certain useful and valuable materials appearing in the months before January 1984 are included. Bibliographical information is provided for books of scholarship, belles-lettres and regional interest, scholarly journals, substantial articles in widely distributed periodicals, theses, and government publications. Newsprint publications, institutional organs, popular promotional magazines and ephemeral works of limited circulation have not been systematically surveyed. Only those items have been included which contain information and opinion essential to a readership interested in a wide variety of aspects of Newfoundland studies and research.

Other surveys descriptive of Newfoundland materials appear in *Canadiana*, *Canadian Historical Review* and *Acadiensis*.
