The IHB has been requested by Mr. David H. GRAY to give the following information about his paper "Where has Sable Island been for the past 200 years?" published in the International Hydrographic Review, Vol. LXIX, No. 2, September 1992.

The 1947 astronomic position of the 1940-47 Sable Island West Light should be corrected to read: 43°56′ 11.32″N, 60°03′10.86″W.

This makes the comparison on page 22 of the IHR to read:

1947 astro. position: 43°56′11.32″N, 60°03′10.86″W (lighthouse)
1899 astro. position: 43°56′<u>24."</u> N, 60°02′<u>47."</u> W (flagstaff)
Difference -12.68" 23.86" (660.6 m)

And at the bottom of page 23 of the IHR:

1947 astro. position: 43°56′11.32″N, 60°03′10.86″W, 1899 astro. position: 43°56′24.″ N, 60°02′47.″ W, 1853 astro. position: 43°56′33.″ N, 60°05′44.6″ W. -3.00 ±(4000m)

(The conclusions drawn from these comparisons do not change; in fact for the first comparison, the error in position determination is less than what was reported.)

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
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
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
