

**INTERNATIONAL GEODETIC BIBLIOGRAPHY.****Volume 2**

The International Hydrographic Bureau has received the *International Geodetic Bibliography*, published by the Secretariat of the International Geodetic Association (19, rue Auber, Paris, 9<sup>e</sup>) under the management of General G. FERRIER, President of the Academy of Sciences, Secretary of the Association, Volume 2 (years 1931 - 32 - 33 - 34), 1938 (64 + 420 pages) (27,5 × 22 cm.), price 200 French francs.

This volume comprises :

An introduction of 64 pages, explaining the slight amendments to the rules of this publication, as set forth in the introduction to Volume I (years 1928 - 29 - 30, issued in 1935) and reproducing the up-to-date list of periodicals published in each country, and the table of the classification adopted.

The Bibliography.

A table of the authors' names in alphabetical order.

The classification adopted is established in accordance with the *Decimal Classification* (International Institute of Brussels), based on a plan worked out by the Secretariat of the Geodetic Association. The tables of the Introduction (p. A. 47 to A. 52) give this classification, and establish, further, the connection with the classification of the "International Catalogue of Scientific Literature (Royal Society)".

Volume 3 (years 1935 - 36 - 37) of this work is in the press, and Volume 4 (years 1938 - 39 - 40) is being prepared.

Geodesists, surveyors and geophysicists will welcome with pleasure the successive volumes of this Bibliography which is of first class help to their work.

The Library of the International Hydrographic Bureau is already in possession of Volume I of this publication.
