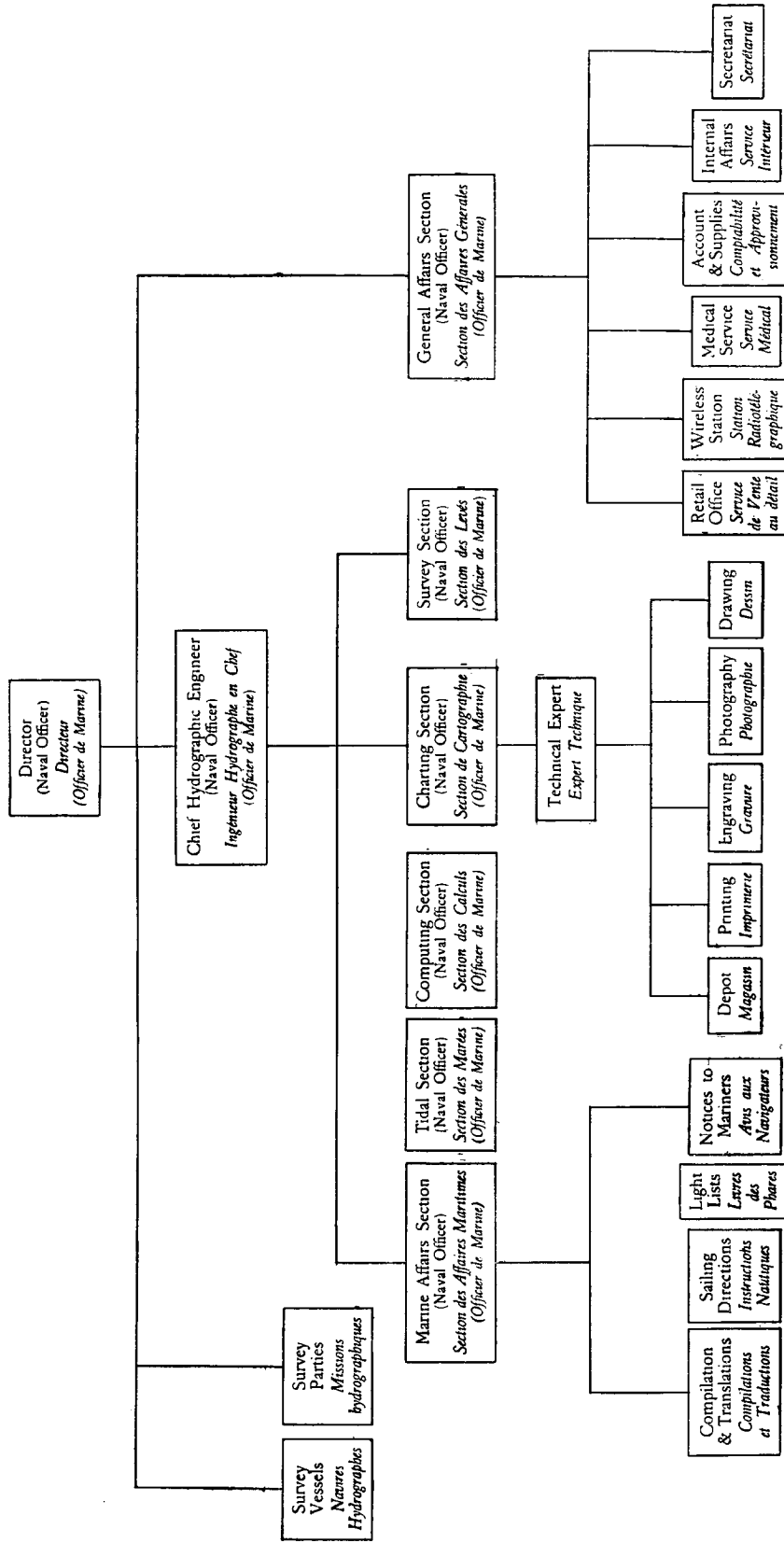

- 1.—Organization of the Hydrographic Department of the Chinese Navy (see diagram).
- 2.—Activities of General Affairs, Survey and Charting Sections:

### A.—GENERAL AFFAIRS SECTION

1. Drafting of documents and correspondence.
2. Compiling of statistics.
3. Registering and filing of all documents.
4. Recording of staff movement and maintenance of personnel discipline.
5. Administering of general affairs and medical service, etc.
6. Selling of charts and nautical publications.
7. Handling of all the documents of the International Hydrographic Bureau.
8. Conducting of miscellaneous duties which do not come under the other sections.

### B.—SURVEY SECTION

1. Planning, directing and investigating of all survey work.
2. Preparation of field working board.
3. Checking of field working board.
4. Equipment and maintenance of survey vessels, aero and land surveys.
5. Training of hydrographical personnel.

### C.—CHARTING SECTION

1. Compilation of International nautical charts.
2. Construction of hydrographic charts of China Coasts and Waters.
3. Photographic Reproduction and Printing.
4. Small Corrections and Publications.
