### MARITIME DISCOVERIES AND EXPLORATIONS

(Page 146 and seq.)

*The following corrections have been communicated by courtesy of the Director of Research of the Discovery Committee, London.*

- Page 146.—Paragraph S 1739 : 3rd line from end of paragraph, should read : not able.....  
is visited by the *Discovery* and by the *Meteor*.....  
*Add* : In 1930 the *Discovery II* charted Bouvet Island and disproved the existence of Thomson Island and the Chimnies. The latter ship sighted Bouvet Island on several occasions and made a landing in 1939.
- Page 166.—S 1925-26, should read : S 1925-27.—Oceanographical research and surveying in the *Discovery* under Stanley Kemp, mainly in Falkland Islands Dependencies. 1926-29, should read : Mercer and Hamilton explore South Georgia.
- Page 167.—S 1929-31, should read : Sir Douglas Mawson in the (barque) *Discovery* discovers MacRobertson Land and the connection between Kemp and Enderby Lands.  
*Delete 3rd line.*  
1929-31, following above should read : 1926-32.—Oceanographical research and surveys by *William Scoresby* (under several leaders in turn) mainly in Dependencies but including survey of the Peru Coastal Current. During 4 subsequent whale marking voyages in the Antarctic (1934-38) this ship visited MacRobertson Land, Kemp Land, the South Sandwich Islands, etc.
- Page 167.—*Add* : 1929-31.—Oceanographical research and surveying in *Discovery II* in Atlantic sector of the Antarctic under Kemp.  
1930-31 : *Replace Discovery II* by *Discovery*.
- Page 168.—*Add the following paragraphs* :
- 1931-33.—Second commission of the *Discovery II* including circumpolar voyage and intensive research in the Atlantic sector, under D. D. John.

1933-35.—Third commission of the *Discovery II* mainly in the Atlantic and Pacific sectors of the Antarctic, under N. A. Mackintosh.  
.....  
1935-37.—Fourth commission of the *Discovery II* mainly in the Atlantic and Indian Ocean sectors of the Antarctic, under G. E. R. Deacon.
- Page 169.—*Add the following paragraph* :
- 1937-39.—Fifth commission of the *Discovery II* including circumpolar voyage and work in the Atlantic sector, mainly under H. F. P. Herdman.
