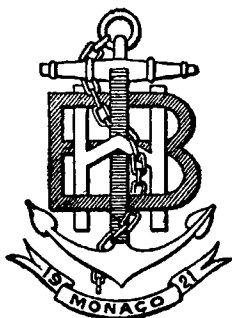

IMPORTANT NOTICE

CONSIGNMENTS TO THE BUREAU

The French Government has kindly consented to permit all instruments, documents and other articles necessary for the work of the Bureau to be imported from other countries free of all customs dues provided that the Ministry of Finance receives previous notification of the proposed importation.

The Secretary-General should therefore be notified of the intended despatch of any such articles and information on the following subjects should be given at the same time : —

- (a) *Name of sender ;*
- (b) *Number of packages ;*
- (c) *Types of packages (box, bale, etc.) ;*
- (d) *Marks on the packages ;*
- (e) *Weight of each package ;*
- (f) *Schedule of contents ;*
- (g) *Date of despatch ;*
- (h) *Probable date and port of entry into France ;*
- (i) *Means of transport (Parcels post, steamer, rail, etc.).*

Unless this information is given in advance the full customs dues are payable and these fall on the Bureau.
